INTRODUCTION TO PATTERN RECOGNITION

Pattern recognition is a part of machine learning and it is concerned with the automatic detection or classification of objects or events. The main objective of a pattern recognition system is to assign an object or an event to one of the several pre-specified categories. The objects or situations to be classified are called as samples or patterns. The set of samples used for the system design is called training set. Pattern recognition algorithms generally aim to provide a reasonable answer for all possible samples and to perform "most likely" matching of the samples with these training sets, taking into account their statistical variations. Some applications of pattern recognition are human speech recognition by computers, gender identification, character recognition, medical diagnostics, sorting of materials, identification of people from fingerprints, voice, retinal scans etc, analysis of satellite pictures to determine agricultural crops, weather etc.

In second session Mr. Vinay Prakash, an Open source enthusiast, conducted hands on workshop on Linux customization with one of his favorite distribution Linux Mint. It is a community-driven Linux distribution based on Debian and Ubuntu that strives to be a "modern, elegant and comfortable operating system which is both powerful and easy to use."Linux Mint provides full out-of-the-box multimedia support by including some proprietary software and comes bundled with a variety of free and open-source applications. He explained the way of installing our favorite software in existing Linux distributions and creating a

custom linux distribution.

Day -2 (27-10-2017)

Day 2 was packed with 3 different sessions on Machine Learning, Artificial Neural Networks & Augmented Reality.

Session I:

Mr. Manu Madhavan (Research Scholar, NIT C) delivered an expert talk on Machine Learning. In his talk he discussed the basic concepts and opportunities of Machine Learning. Also he stressed the need and importance of Python in Machine Learning.



Session II:

Miss. Amrutha Sethu, handled a session on Evolution of 'Artificial Neural Networks'. Artificial neural networks (ANNs) or connectionist systems are computing systems inspired by the biological neural networks that constitute animal brains. Such systems learn (progressively improve performance) to do tasks by considering examples, generally without task-specific programming.

Session III:

The Day-3 started with Augmented Reality by Mr.Sanjay. Augmented reality (AR) is a live direct or indirect view of a physical, real-world environment whose elements are "augmented" by computer-generated or extracted real-world sensory input such as sound, video, graphics, haptics or GPS data. It is related to a more general concept called computer-mediated reality, in which a view of reality is modified (possibly even diminished rather than augmented) by a computer. Augmented reality enhances one's current perception of reality, whereas in contrast, virtual reality replaces the real world with a simulated one. Augmented reality is used in order to enhance the experienced environments or situations and to offer enriched experiences.

Day -3 (28-10-2017)

Mr. Saneesh P.S. conducted hands on training session for the faculty members and students from different departments on LaTeX. LaTeX is widely used in academia for the communication and publication of scientific documents in many fields, including mathematics, statistics, computer science, engineering, chemistry, physics, economics, linguistics, quantitative psychology, philosophy, and political science. It also has a prominent role in the preparation and publication of books and articles that contain complex multilingual materials.

Workshop on Machine Learning using Python

SIMAT IEDC (Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Center) conducted a one day workshop on Machine Learning using Python in association with ICFOSS (International Center for Free & Open Source Software) and Dept. of CSE on 4th November 2017.

Mr. Manu Madhavan, Research scholar, NIT Calicut, handled the day with Machine Learning with Python. He gave an insight to NumPy, SciPy, Pandas.

NumPy is a collection of software specifically designed for scientific computing in Python (do not confuse with SciPy library, which is part of this stack, and the community around this stack). This way we want to start with a look at it. However, the stack is pretty vast, there is more than a dozen of libraries in it, and we want to put a focal point on the core packages (particularly the most essential ones).


SciPy is a library of software for engineering and science. Again you need to understand the difference between SciPy Stack and SciPy Library. SciPy contains modules for linear algebra, optimization, integration, and statistics. The main functionality of SciPy library is built upon NumPy, and its arrays thus make substantial use of NumPy. It provides efficient numerical routines as numerical integration, optimization, and many others via its specific submodules. The functions in all submodules of SciPy are well documented—another coin in its pot.

Pandas is a Python package designed to do work with "labeled" and "relational" data simple and intuitive. Pandas is a perfect tool for data wrangling. It designed for quick and easy data manipulation, aggregation, and visualization.



Workshop on e-Sim

SIMAT IEDC (Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Center) conducted a one day workshop on e-Sim in association with ICFOSS (International Center for Free & Open Source Software) and Dept. of EEE on 16th November 2017. e-Sim (previously known as Oscad / FreeEDA) is an open source EDA tool for circuit design, simulation, analysis and PCB design. It is an integrated tool built using open source software such as KiCad and Ngspice. eSim is released under GPL. eSim offers similar capabilities and ease of use as any equivalent proprietary software for schematic creation, simulation and PCB design, without having to pay a huge amount of money to procure licenses. Hence it can be an affordable alternative to educational institutions and SMEs. It can serve as an alternative to commercially available/ licensed software tools like OrCAD, Xpedition and HSPICE.

The workshop was inaugurated by Prof. Thankachen P V on 16th November 2017. Mr. Sebin Sunny P (Assistant Professor, Dept. of EEE), Ms. Sangeetha K (Asst. Prof, Dept. of EEE) & Mr. Suhas K N (Lab Instructor, Dept. of EEE) handled the workshop. The workshop started with an introduction to EDA tools (Electronic Computer Aided Design). Students were given a basic idea about free and open source software's commonly used in circuit simulation and design during this session. The hands on training session started with introduction to the basic concepts like project creation, schematic creation, net list preparation and simulation steps. Students were given different circuits like rectifiers, regulators, amplifiers, operational amplifiers, oscillators, timer circuits etc and they were given the basic knowledge to draw the circuit, analyze the circuit and simulate the circuit. Also the students were familiarized with reading the input and output waveforms from the e-Sim software.





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
