A few observations made while I was referring to the faculty evaluation sheets are,

- 1. All the comments made by S1 S2 students about the teaching methods are in English. About 95% of the comments are in good English technically and grammatically correct.
- 2. S1 S2 students make genuine comments about the teaching methods.

I was not able to get similar observations when I was referring to the feedback given by senior students. Most of the comments are in the so called Mangleesh and many deviating from the task.

I made similar observations during last year also which means students maintain quality and decorrum while in first year and slowly deteriorate while entering senior classes.

The very purpose of Education is value addition apart from the degree one receives from the University.

I fear instead of value addition, dilution takes place as you grow in to higher classes. The students tend to be more casual and less serious about the main tasks.

The main remark by corporate representatives about the job seekers from Kerala is that they are weak in good communication.

When you are striving to settle down with a good job, you have to be more serious about your activities and develop right attitude during your studies. You have to avoid the short form English / SMS type of communication / Mangleesh etc.

I am confident that you can, if you try.
