I. INTRODUCTION

SREEPATHY INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT AND TECHNOLOGY is intended to be self-financing Engineering college with a distinct identity and a center of excellence different from the many engineering colleges in Kerala. SIMAT is situated on a small hillock, in the midst of verdant and scenic beauty which provides a perfect setting of serenity and peace for the campus in the pursuit of excellence. It's location in vavanoor, 400 meters from Palakkad – Guruvayur state highway makes it conveniently accessible by all forms of transportation.

The college is approved by AICTE, New-Delhi and Government of Kerala and also affiliated to University of Calicut & A P J Abdul Kalam Technological University (KTU).

The prospectus gives the rules and regulations for admission of students to the B. Tech courses for the academic year 2016-17

II. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION Under Management and Government Quota.

1. Candidates must be citizen of India

2. (a) Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Mathematics separately, and 50 % marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together are eligible for admission. However candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together are eligible for admission under Management Quota in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges/Government Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, the marks obtained in Computer Science shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry and Computer Science, the marks obtained in Biotechnology shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, Computer Science and Biotechnology, the marks obtained in Biology shall be considered. The marks as shown in the mark list of the Board of Examination obtained from the respective Higher Secondary Board shall be considered for academic eligibility.

Note:- (i) In two year Kerala Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognised equivalent thereto with two year course where the Board Examinations are conducted in both years, the total marks of two years in the respective subjects as shown in the mark lists of the respective Higher Secondary Boards will be considered for academic eligibility.

(ii) In Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognised equivalent thereto where Board Examinations are conducted only at the end of 12th class (final year), the marks in the respective subjects as shown in the mark lists of the respective Higher Secondary Boards will be considered for academic eligibility.

(iii) For all other type of Higher Secondary courses or examinations recognised equivalent

- 3. Candidates should qualify Engineering entrance examination conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala.
- 4. Final admission will be based on the conditions prescribed by the Commissioner for

Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala from time to time.

Under NRI Quota

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto with 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry put together are eligible for admission. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, the marks obtained in Computer Science shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry and Computer Science, the marks obtained in Biotechnology shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, Computer Science, Biotechnology, the marks obtained in Biology shall be considered. The marks as shown in the mark list of the Board of Examination obtained from the respective Higher Secondary Board shall be considered for academic eligibility.

Under Lateral Entry

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Engineering awarded by the State Board of Technical Education or Equivalent after undergoing regular course of three years in an approved institution are eligible for admission. All admissions will be as per the rank list prepared by the Joint Controller of Technical Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram. Maximum age at the time of admission will be 28 years.

IV. HOW TO APPLY

- The application form for management quota can be obtained from the college or from the Sreepathy Trust office, Thekkemadhom road, Pazhaya NadakkavuThrissur-680001 during working hours on payment of prescribed fee which is Rs.500/- for Management quota and Rs.1000/- for NRI quota.
- The application duly filled in along with the copies of certificates required shall be submitted before the prescribed date. Application submitted should be completed in all respects. The copies of the certificates should be attested by the competent authorities.

VI. FEES.

The fees for Government quota admission will be strictly as prescribed by the Government.

- Note: 1. The fee waiver scheme is applicable to the students for the entire course.
 - 2. The students need to pay only the balance fee (if any) after the deduction of scholarship amount at the time of admission.

- VIII. Any student who got admission under Management or NRI quota or Lateral entry, later discontinues his/her study after the closure of admission shall be liable to pay the entire tuition fee for the remaining years for issue of transfer certificate.
- **IX.** Hostel facilities are available for both boys and girls. Hostel fees are collected on annual basis. The payment can be made either in lump sum or in two installments.
- **X.** Transport facilities are provided. The payments are to be made in advance and lump sum.

XI. PROHIBITION OF RAGGING.

- Ragging is a cognizable offense and punishable under provisions of ragging act. Ragging/ any type of misconduct towards any students either in the college campus or outside will be considered as criminal offence and will be immediately reported to police. Such students will not be permitted to continue their studies.
